Dear Mr. Hatch:

SEG, Inc., the producer ("Producer") of the highly acclaimed SURVIVOR television series (the "Series") which airs on the CBS Television Network, would like to extend an offer in which you may participate in the upcoming cycle of the Series ("Cycle 20") which will be filmed in Samoa. This cycle is particularly significant given that it coincides with the 10 year anniversary of the series and your victory as the winner of Cycle 1 of the Series.

You would need to be available for principal filming on Cycle 20, which is presently expected to commence on or around August 1, 2009 and conclude on or around September 20, 2009 (dates may vary slightly depending upon production needs), and for all required press and publicity that would occur around the time you would be traveling with other participants to Samoa. Additionally, you would also need to be available for two to three days in late July, 2009 (exact dates to be determined) for a medical and a psychological evaluation. Finally, you would need to be available to participate in press and publicity on the day after the broadcast of the episode in which you either are eliminated or declared the winner and in the live finale episode of Cycle 20, which is presently scheduled to air in early to mid- December of this year.

This offer is contingent upon: (a) your successful completion of a physical and a psychological examination as well as a background investigation; (b) execution of all of Producer's standard documents required of contestants participating in Cycle 20 including, without limitation, (i) Interview Agreement, (ii) Survivor 20 Applicant Agreement, (iii) Release and Waiver and Agreement Not to Sue and Indemnification and Hold Harmless Agreement, (iv) Physical Test / Trial Liability Release, (v) Authorization for Release of Medical Information, and (vi) the Survivor 20 Rules; and (c) the CBS Television Network giving its final approval of your participation in Cycle 20.
