AND POTENTIAL REQUIREMENT OF COMMUNITY SERVICE**

DEAR JUDGE SCHNEGG:

MY NAME IS BRYAN T. NORWOOD AND I AM THE CHIEF OF POLICE FOR THE RICHMOND POLICE DEPARTMENT IN RICHMOND, VIRGINIA. THE PURPOSE OF THIS LETTER IS TO MEMORIALIZE FOR YOUR PURPOSES MY CONVERSATION WITH MR. GERAGOS, CHRIS BROWN'S LAWYER, IN WHICH I CONFIRMED THAT OUR DEPARTMENT IS WILLING TO SUPERVISE AND ORCHESTRATE THE COMMUNITY SERVICE PORTION OF THE SENTENCE YOU IMPOSE ON MR. BROWN.

IT IS MY UNDERSTANDING THAT THE COURT DESIRES THE IMPOSED COMMUNITY SERVICE TO BE LABOR INTENSIVE. ALONG THOSE LINES, WE ARE PREPARED TO PUT MR. BROWN TO WORK IN THE COMMUNITY PERFORMING MANUAL LABOR TASKS, SUCH AS GRAFFITI REMOVAL, TRASH PICK UP, WASHING CARS, CLEANING, MAINTAINING GROUNDS, ETC. ACCORDINGLY, HIS ACTIVITIES WOULD BE PERFORMED UNDER THE SUPERVISION OF MYSELF AND THOSE UNDER MY COMMAND AND HE WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR PAYING ANY COSTS INCURRED REGARDING THE FACILITATION OF THIS ARRANGEMENT TO INCLUDE, ADEQUATE SECURITY FROM THE PUBLIC (IN THE EVENT THEY BECOME AWARE OF HIS PRESENCE) AND ONE-ON-ONE SUPERVISION WHERE SPECIAL PROJECTS ARE INSTITUTED. PROPER DOCUMENTATION OF HIS DAYS/HOURS WORKED WILL BE MAINTAINED IN OUR FILES AND WE ARE WILLING TO PROVIDE PROGRESS REPORTS TO THE COURT IF THE COURT REQUIRES SUCH.
