ON WEDNESDAY 10/28/2009 I (SPO R JORDAN) RESPONDED TO THE INCIDENT LOCATION REFERENCE FLORENCE COUNTY EMS REQUESTING LAW ENFORCEMENT ASSISTANCE DUE TO A PATIENT BEING DISORDERLY. UPON ARRIVAL I OBSERVED THE SUBJECT (ECHOLS) WEARING NOTHING BUT A RED SWEATSHIRT BEING RESTRAINED BY EMS AND ANOTHER RESIDENT OF THE APARTMENT COMPLEX. ECHOLS HAD A LARGE ROAD RASH AREA ON THE RIGHT SIDE OF HIS FACE THAT WAS HEAVILY BLEEDING ALONG WITH HIS MOUTH. EMS ADVISED THE SUBJECT HAD A SEIZURE AND FELL. ECHOLS APPEARED TO BE DISORIENTED AND WAS BABBLING SOUNDS BUT NO ACTUAL WORDS. AS ONE OF THE EMS TECHNICIANS PULLED THE STRETCHER FROM THE AMBULANCE ECHOLS IMMEDIATELY BEGAN TO SCREAM, PULL AWAY AND FIGHT WITH THE EMS TECH, AND THE RESIDENT. I ORDERED THEM TO LET HIM GO SO THEY WOULD NOT BE INJURED. ECHOLS THEN BEGAN TO SCREAM NONSENSE WORDS AS HE JOGGED OUT OF THE COMPLEX AND THEN BEGAN TO WALK EAST ON PINE STREET. I CALLED FOR ANOTHER UNIT TO ASSIST IN DETAINING ECHOLS DUE TO HIS OBVIOUS MENTAL STATE AND MEDICAL CONDITION. I THEN FOLLOWED ECHOLS DOWN THE PINE ST SIDEWALK WHEN SPO JAMES ARRIVED. SPO JAMES ADVISED HE WAS FAMILIAR WITH THE SUBJECT REFERENCE CASE # 2008-009983 WHERE ECHOLS HAD TO BE PHYSICALLY RESTRAINED BY OFFICERS AND ATTEMPTED TO RUN IN THE STREET. AS MYSELF AND SPO JAMES ATTEMPTED TO APPROACH AND DETAIN ECHOLS HE VIOLENTLY PULLED AWAY AND BEGAN TO SPIT BLOOD AND STRIKE AT US. ECHOLS THEN BEGAN TO RUN INTO EAST PINE ST AT WHICH TIME I DEPLOYED MY X26 TASER WHICH HAD LITTLE TO NO EFFECT. SPO JAMES SEEING MY TASER HAD NO EFFECT THEN DEPLOYED HIS TASER WITH THE SAME RESULT. WE THEN BEGAN TO CHASE ECHOLS EAST ON PINE STREET. SPO JAMES ATTEMPTED TO GRAB ECHOL'S ARM WHEN ECHOLS TURNED AND SWUNG AT HIM. I THEN DEPLOYED MY ASP TO ECHOL'S RIGHT LEG CAUSING HIM TO GO TO THE GROUND. ONCE ON THE GROUND ECHOLS CONTINUED TO FIGHT WITH MYSELF AND SPO JAMES. ECHOLS WAS ORDERED TO STAY ON THE GROUND BUT DID NOT COMPLY AND CONTINUED TO SCREAM AND SPIT BLOOD AT US. ECHOLS CONTINUED TO TRY AND GET UP AND AT TIMES GRABBING MYSELF AND SPO JAMES. I THEN ATTEMPTED TO DRIVE STUN ECHOLS SEVERAL TIMES IN THE

LEG AND ARM BUT THAT TOO HAD LITTLE TO NO EFFECT. I WAS ABLE TO PLACE ONE HANDCUFF ON ECHOLS AT WHICH TIME ECHOLS BIT MY RIGHT HAND POINTER FINGER. ECHOLS THEN ATTEMPTED TO BITE SPO JAMES AS WE WERE TRYING TO KEEP ECHOLS ON THE GROUND. ECHOLS THEN CONTINUED TO SCREAM SPITTING BLOOD AT MYSELF AND SPO JAMES. ADDITIONAL UNITS WERE ENROUTE AND AS IN AN ATTEMPT TO HOLD ECHOLS DOWN I PLACED MY KNEE AND AT TIMES MY LEFT FOOT ON HIS CHEST IN AN ATTEMPT TO HOLD HIM DOWN SO HE WOULD NOT BE ABLE TO SPIT BLOOD IN MY FACE. TRANSPORT OFFICER HOLMES WAS FIRST TO RESPOND AND ATTEMPTED TO HELP DETAIN ECHOLS WITH LITTLE RESULT. CPL JACOBS THEN ARRIVED AND UPON SEEING MYSELF AND SPO JAMES AND TRANSPORT OFFICER HOLMES STILL STRUGGLING WITH ECHOLS CPL JACOBS REMOVED K-9 OFFICER BEAR FROM HIS VEHICLE AND BEGAN TO GIVE LOUD VERBAL COMMANDS ORDERING ECHOLS TO LISTEN TO OFFICER'S COMMANDS AND STOP RESISTING. AFTER ASSISTANCE FROM CPL FORD, SGT BRANDT, OFFICER DAVIS, SGT CALHOUN, AND CPL JACOBS, ECHOLS WAS FINALLY DETAINED WITH HANDCUFFS AND LEG SHACKLES. ECHOLS WAS THEN PLACED AND RESTRAINED TO A BACK BOARD AND TRANSPORTED TO MCLEOD BY EMS. MYSELF AND SPO JAMES HAD TO CHANGE UNIFORMS DUE TO THE AMOUNT OF BLOOD FROM ECHOLS SPITTING AND STRUGGLING WITH US. WE RESPONDED TO CAROLINA OCCUPATIONAL HEALTH WHERE I WAS TREATED FOR THE BITE ON MY FINGER AND EXPOSURE TO BLOOD. THIS ENTIRE INCIDENT WAS RECORDED ON MY DVR. A USE OF FORCE FORM WAS FILED. MYSELF AND SPO JAMES TASER CARTRIDGES WERE LOGGED INTO EVIDENCE UNDER LOG # 09-1594. A SUPPLEMENTAL WILL ALSO BE FILED WITH EMS TECHNICIANS (WITNESS 1 AND 2) STATEMENT OF THE INCIDENT. NO FURTHER INFORMATION AT THIS TIME.

IN REFERENCE TO THE ABOVE CASE NUMBER THIS UNIT RESPONDED TO ASSIST OFFICERS REQUESTING ADDITIONAL ASSISTANCE IN THE 900 BLOCK OF E PINE STREET. UNITS RESPONDED AND WHEN THEY ARRIVED ON SCENE THEY FOUND SPO JAMES AND SPO JORDAN ON THE GROUND ATTEMPTING TO RESTRAIN A SUBJECT (TERRELL ECHOLS). THIS UNIT VIEWED THE SUBJECT BEING EXTREMELY UNCOOPERATIVE AND COMBATIVE. THIS UNIT WENT OVER AND GRABBED THE LOOSE HANDCUFF THAT WAS ATTEMPTING TO BE PLACED ON ECHOLS AND WITH THE ASSISTANCE OF OTHER OFFICERS WERE ABLE TO SECURE THEM. OFFICERS GAVE ECHOLS VERBAL COMMANDS IN AN ATTEMPT TO CALM HIM DOWN AND ADVISE HIM THAT LAW ENFORCEMENT AND EMS WAS TRYING TO GET HIM TO THE HOSPITAL FOR ASSISTANCE. THIS UNIT THEN NOTICED THAT ECHOLS WAS PARTIALLY CLOTHED AND ONLY HAD A SHIRT/SWEATSHIRT ON AND NO SHOES. WHILE HANDCUFFED, ECHOLS STILL ATTEMPTED TO GET UP FROM THE GROUND AND WAS STILL COMBATIVE. ECHOLS WOULD GRAB THE PANTS AND HANDS OF OFFICERS FOR NO APPARENT REASON. AT ONE POINT, ECHOLS ATTEMPTED TO BITE THE SHOES OF AN OFFICER. ECHOLS WOULD SCREAM OUT FROM TIME TO TIME VARIOUS STATEMENTS ("DADDY MY DICK" "DADDY I CAN'T BREATHE") AND SOME INAUDIBLE STATEMENTS. EMS WAS STANDING BY UNTIL UNITS WERE ABLE TO RESTRAIN ECHOLS. ECHOLS WAS THEN LIFTED OFF OF THE GROUND, PLACED ON A BACKBOARD, AND THEN A STRETCHER. ECHOLS WAS RESTRAINED ONCE ON THE STRETCHER. AT THIS POINT ECHOLS WAS SOMEWHAT CALM, BUT STILL EXHIBITED UNUSUAL BEHAVIOR. ECHOLS WAS TRANSPORTED TO MCLCOP HOSPITAL TO BE TREATED.

BACK UP

I HEARD VIA RADIO OFFICERS REQUESTING BACK UP AT PINE ST & BALLARD ST WHERE ONE OFFICER STATED OVER THE RADIO THAT THE SUSPECT WAS TASTED AND HE NEEDED MORE HELP. I TOLD DISPATCH I WAS ENROUTE FROM WEST LUCAS STREET. AS I WAS IN ROUTE DISPATCH MADE SEVERAL ATTEMPTS TO GET A STATUS FROM OFFICERS ON SCENE BUT THEY COULD NOT ANSWER THE RADIO. UPON ARRIVAL I SAW OFFICERS STRUGGLING WITH A BLACK MALE WHO WAS ON THE GROUND BUT BEING VERY COMBATIVE. AS I EXITED MY MARKED K-9 VEHICLE I GOT K-9 BEAR OUT AND HELD HIM BY HIS PATROL HARNESS AND HIS CHOKE COLLAR AND STOOD ABOUT 5 TO 6 FEET FROM WHERE THE OFFICERS WERE STRUGGLING WITH THE SUBJECT AND GAVE K-9 BEAR HIS GUARD AND BARK COMMAND. I GAVE LOUD COMMANDS TO THE SUBJECT TO "DO WHAT THE OFFICERS ARE TELLING YOU TO DO". I REPEATED MY ORDERS AND THEN STATED "PUT YOUR HANDS BEHIND YOUR BACK". CPL FORD THEN STATED "WE GOT HIM" AND I COULD SEE THE SUBJECT WAS CUFFED SO I THEN PUT K-9 BEAR BACK IN THE PATROL VEHICLE IN HIS KENNEL. I WAS THEN HELPING OFFICERS HOLD THE SUBJECT DOWN WHILE THE SUSPECT WAS STILL CUFFED WHEN I REALIZED THE SUBJECT APPEARED TO HAVE SOME MENTAL ISSUES.

DISORDERLY PATIENT

ON 10/28/2009 WEDNESDAY THIS UNIT RESPONDED ALONG WITH SPO JORDAN TO ASSIST EMS WITH A DISORDERLY PATIENT AT 837 E PINE STREET. WHILE ENROUTE TO PINE ST THIS UNIT ASKED CENTRAL TO CHECK THE STATUS OF THE EMS EMPLOYEES. CENTRAL ADVISED UNITS (EMS) WERE CODE-3 AT THE TIME. SPO JORDAN ARRIVED ON SCENE AND SHORTLY AFTER HIS ARRIVAL HE ASKED ME (SPO JAMES) FOR MY LOCATION. THIS UNIT ADVISED SPO JORDAN MY LOCATION AND SPO JORDAN ASKED THIS UNIT TO STEP IT UP (CODE-2). SPO JORDAN ADVISED THIS UNIT THE SUBJECT WAS WALKING EAST ON PINE ST WITH BLOOD COMING FROM HIS MOUTH. THIS UNIT ARRIVED ON SCENE AND AS SOON AS I (SPO JAMES) GOT OUT OF MY VEHICLE THE SUBJECT TOOK OFF RUNNING EAST ON PINE ST. THIS UNIT WAS FAMILIAR WITH THE SUBJECT AND HIS MENTAL STATUS DUE TO A PREVIOUS CALL EARLIER IN THE MONTH (SEE CASE#2009-009983). THIS UNIT ADVISED SPO JORDAN NOT TO LET HIM RUN INTO THE ROADWAY DUE TO SERIOUS SAFETY CONCERNS. SPO JORDAN FIRED HIS X-26 TASER IN AN ATTEMPT TO STOP THE SUBJECT FROM GETTING INTO THE ROADWAY. SPO JORDAN'S TASER HAD NO EFFECT ON THE SUBJECT AND I (OFFICER JAMES) ATTEMPTED TO USE MY X-26 TASER ON THE SUBJECT. NEITHER TASER WAS EFFECTIVE ON THE SUBJECT AND THE SUBJECT STARTED TO RUN INTO TRAFFIC. THIS UNIT WENT HANDS ON AND GRABBED THE SUBJECT'S LEFT ARM PULLING HIM TO THE GROUND. AS I (OFFICER JAMES) PULLED THE SUBJECT HE STARTED ACTIVELY FIGHTING ME. ONCE ON THE GROUND THE SUBJECT BEGAN TO FIGHT WITH SPO JORDAN AND MYSELF IN A VIOLENT MANNER. THIS UNIT ATTEMPTED TO RESTRAIN THE SUBJECT WITH HANDCUFFS TO PREVENT ANY FURTHER INJURY TO HIMSELF OR ANY ONE ELSE. IT WAS CLEAR TO THIS UNIT THAT MYSELF AND SPO JORDAN COULD NOT SECURE THE SUBJECT WITH ONLY TWO OF US (OFFICERS). THIS UNIT JUST HELD THE SUBJECT DOWN BY SITTING ON TOP OF THE SUBJECT WITH HIS BACK ON THE GROUND WHILE HOLDING HIS HANDS DOWN UNTIL BACK-UP COULD ARRIVE. ONCE OTHER OFFICERS WERE ON SCENE THE SUBJECT WAS RESTRAINED AND TRANSPORTED TO MOLECOD'S EMERGENCY ROOM. THIS UNIT COMPLETED A USE OF FORCE FORM AND THERE IS NO FURTHER INFORMATION AT THE TIME THIS REPORT WAS COMPLETED.

DISORDERLY SUBJECT

SGT. M. C. BRANDT- 205B

10/28/2009

ON 10/28/2009 AT APPROXIMATELY 0919 HRS, I HEARD OFFICER ROBERT JORDAN'S RADIO CALL FOR ASSISTANCE AND RESPONDED TO HIM FROM MY OFFICE ON THE SECOND FLOOR OF THE CITY/ COUNTY COMPLEX. UPON MY ARRIVAL, OFFICERS ON THE SCENE HAD THE SUSPECT ON THE ROADWAY HOLDING HIM DOWN. THE SUBJECT WAS YELLING INCOHERENTLY AND STRUGGLING WITH THE OFFICERS. THE SUBJECT WAS ON HIS RIGHT SIDE WITH HIS HANDS CUFFED TO THE REAR. THE SUBJECT WAS CUFFED WITH (2) SETS OF CUFFS LINKED TOGETHER, ALLOWING HIM SIGNIFICANT MOVEMENT OF HIS ARMS AND HANDS. THE SUBJECT CONTINUOUSLY GRABBED OFFICER'S HANDS AND LEGS AS HE STRUGGLED. AS I APPROACHED, CPL FORD REQUESTED A SHEET FROM EMS WORKERS TO COVER THE SUBJECT WHO WAS NOT CLOTHED FROM THE WAIST DOWN. I DONNED NITRILE GLOVES AND ASSISTED IN PULLING THE SUBJECT'S HANDS OFF OF OTHER OFFICERS LEGS AND HANDS. THE SUBJECT HAD A VACANT LOOK IN HIS EYES AS HE THRASHED AROUND. I ADVISED HIM TO CALM DOWN, BUT THE SUBJECT WAS UNRESPONSIVE TO MY VOICE. CPL JACOBS AND I THEN USED MY CUFFS TO SECURE THE SUBJECT'S HANDS THEN REMOVED THE LINKED CUFFS. WE WERE ABLE TO STRAP THE SUBJECT IN THE SUPINE (FACE UP) POSITION ON A BACKBOARD AND PLACE HIM ON THE STRETCHER. A DISPOSABLE FILTER MASK WAS PLACED OVER HIS MOUTH BECAUSE THE SUBJECT BEGAN SPITTING BLOOD OUT OF HIS MOUTH. WHILE PLACING THE SUBJECT IN THE AMBULANCE HE SEEMED TO BE SOMEWHAT RESPONSIVE TO MY VOICE. I ADVISED EMS THAT I WOULD RIDE TO THE HOSPITAL WITH THE SUBJECT AND TURNED OVER MY KEYS TO LT JORDAN. LT JORDAN ADVISED ME THAT BLOOD WAS ON MY KEY. I THEN OBSERVED BLOOD ON MY FOREARMS AND USED HAND SANITIZER TO CLEAN IT OFF. LT JORDAN ALSO ASSIGNED OFFICER JOHN DAVIS TO RIDE IN THE AMBULANCE. DURING THE RIDE TO MCLEOD ER, THE SUBJECT BECAME MORE VERBALLY RESPONSIVE AND REFERRED TO ME AS "DADDY". HE REFERRED TO OFFICER DAVIS AS "LORD JESUS". I ADVISED THE SUBJECT TO CALM DOWN AND THAT WE WOULD GET HIM HELP. THE SUBJECT STATED " OKAY DADDY, OK, I GOTTA PEE PEE, DADDY" REPEATEDLY ENROUTE TO THE HOSPITAL. I STAYED WITH THE SUBJECT UNTIL THE SUBJECT WAS SEDATED AND MCLEOD SECURITY PLACED THE SUBJECT IN SOFT RESTRAINTS. I THEN RESPONDED TO CAROLINA'S URGENT CARE OCCUPATIONAL HEALTH FOR A MEDICAL ASSESSMENT.

WITNESS STATEMENT FROM FLORENCE COUNTY EME TECHNICIANS

ON WEDNESDAY AT 1510 HOURS I MET WITH CORPORAL CLARISSA LUKE AND PRIVATE KELLY TURNER OF FLORENCE COUNTY EMS TO PROVIDE ME WITH THEIR ACCOUNT OF THE ABOVE INCIDENT. LUKE STATED THEY RECEIVED A CALL OF A SUBJECT THAT HAD A SEIZURE AND HAD FALLEN. UPON ARRIVAL LUKE ADVISED OBSERVING THE SUBJECT (ECHOLS) LAYING ON THE CONCRETE PARKING LOT OF THE APARTMENT COMPLEX WEARING NOTHING BUT A RED SWEATSHIRT. AS THEY PULLED UP ECHOLS GOT UP OFF THE GROUND AND ATTEMPTED TO LEAVE WHEN ANOTHER TENANT RESTRAINED HIM. LUKE ADVISED ECHOLS HAD A LARGE ABRASION ON THE RIGHT SIDE OF HIS FACE THAT WAS BLEEDING AS WELL AS A LACERATED LIP AND TOE. LUKE ADVISED SHE ATTEMPTED TO HELP RESTRAIN ECHOLS WITH THE OTHER TENANT WHILE TURNER REMOVED THE STRETCHER FROM THE AMBULANCE. LUKE ADVISED WHEN ECHOLS SAW TURNER PULL THE STRETCHER OUT THAT'S WHEN HE "FLIPPED OUT" AND BEGAN TO STRUGGLE WITH HER. SHE LET HIM GO AND WATCHED AS I CHASED HIM DOWN PINE ST. LUKE ADVISED IT TOOK THEM A MINUTE OR SO TO TURN THE AMBULANCE AROUND AND RESPOND TO OUR LOCATION WHERE WE WERE STRUGGLING WITH ECHOLS. LUKE ADVISED WHEN THEY PULLED UP ECHOLS WAS FIGHTING WITH THREE OF US (POLICE OFFICERS). LUKE ADVISED SHE OBSERVED ECHOLS CONTINUE TO BE BELLIGERENT WHILE WE WERE STRUGGLING WITH HIM AND NOT LISTEN TO OUR COMMANDS. TURNER ADDED THAT DURING THE STRUGGLE ECHOLS WAS CONSTANTLY RUBBING HIS FACE IN THE GROUND. BOTH LUKE AND TURNER ADVISED THEY OBSERVED NO ACTIONS BY LAW ENFORCEMENT THEY FELT WERE EXCESSIVE DUE TO THE CIRCUMSTANCES AND ECHOL'S CONDITION. I ALSO ASKED BOTH IF THEY OBSERVED ANY INJURIES TO ECHOLS AFTER THE INCIDENT THAT THEY DID NOT OBSERVE WHEN THEY MADE FIRST CONTACT. BOTH TURNER AND LUKE ADVISED THEY DID NOT SEE ANY ADDITIONAL INJURIES TO ECHOLS THAT HE DID NOT ALREADY HAVE AS A RESULT OF THE INITIAL SEIZURE AND FALL. ALL QUESTIONING WAS RECORDED ON DVR. NO FURTHER INFORMATION AT THIS TIME.
